Disassemble mechanism, clean all parts and reassemble mechanism				
Electronics of machine (solenoids, relays, and circuit boards)				
Wire lights (Work Off Batteries)				
Wire lights (Work Off Plug In Power Supply)				
Hand polish all brass nails on playing field				
Replace the playing field background artwork (includes polish all brass nails)				
Yellowing plastic treatment (Lightens yellowing plastic)				
Soak all frame steel parts in rust remover and seal with rust preventer				
Soak all chrome parts in rust remover and hand polish				
Rekey Lock (Nishijin N type Locks Only)				
Touch up paint and/or foiling on playing field features (as needed)				
Pachinko Wall Mount Cabinet Kit				
Finished Pachinko Foot Mounting boards				
Replace Plexiglas				
Replace Glass				
Refinish wood frame face (If not laminate)				
Lost ball catch tray (Free with 500 count ball order)				
Replace broken and missing parts as needed (if available) (Under \$100)				
Pachinko Balls 250 count (200 pachinko balls minimum for play)				
Pachinko Balls 500 count (Recommended for playing Vintage Pachinko)
